

**U.N. Unit Due in Hanoi**

GENEVA, June 11 — The United Nations High Commissioner for Refugees announced today that he would open an office in Hanoi under an agreement signed with the Government of North Vietnam.

In a statement issued here, the High Commissioner, Prince Sadruddih Aga Khan, said the office would facilitate coordination with North Vietnam in the field of humanitarian assistance and accelerate the implementation of his projects in that country.
