

'Many Sponsors' Needed For Vietnam Refugees

A spokesman for Catholic Social Service denied reports yesterday that sponsors no longer are needed for refugees from Vietnam and Cambodia.

An Associated Press dispatch from Camp Pendleton that appeared in Thursday's Chronicle was described as "incorrect" by the Rev. Ron Tognoli.

Father Tognoli said that with Camp Pendleton closing in the

immediate future, some 20,000 unsponsored refugees are flocking to Fort Chaffee, Ark.

"We need many many sponsors, particularly church groups, for these people," Father Tognoli said.
