He had been questioned about a report that a company of the United States Ninth Infantry Division had fired on an occupied village in the Delta

for "target practice."

The report said the firing I took place in June northwest of the division's base at Dongtam, 40 miles southwest of

Saigon.
The spokesman said, "an investigation was held into an incident northwest of Dongtam in the same time period of June in which one person was killed and one person was in-

volved."
"This original investigation was a military investigation and this has turnedit into a criminal investigation," he said.

In Mekong Incident the other person as an American soldier, the spokesman would not comment further.

He did say, however, this was the only incident reported in the area.

Dongtam was evacuated by withdrawals.
