
Mylai Drug Question Raised

WASHINGTON, March 15 (Reuters) — Senator Thomas J. Dodd announced Sunday the opening of an investigation into a possible connection between the alleged Mylai massacre and the use of drugs by American soldiers in South Vietnam. The Connecticut Democrat said testimony would begin before his juvenile delinquency subcommittee March 24. There has been no public mention by the Government of drug use by the soldiers who have been implicated in the alleged massacre in March 1968.
