Capt. Ernest Medina will submit his resignation to the Army next week and, according to his attorney, F. Lee Bailey, he will join the Enstrom Helicopter Company as an assistant to the chairman of the board, Mr. Bailey defended Captain Medina—successfully—against murder charges in the Mylai massacre in Vietnam. Asked what he plans to do for Entrom, a helicopter company in the upper Michigan community of Menominee, Captain Medina said, "I want to learn anything I can about the helicopter business."
