

**Key Witness in Calley Case  
Seized on Perjury Charge**

TULSA, Okla., July 29 (AP) — Charles Dean Gruver, the key "missing witness" in efforts to win a new court-martial for First Lieut. William L. Calley Jr., was arrested by the Tulsa police Saturday on a warrant charging him with perjury.

The perjury charge was filed yesterday at Pryor, Okla., in connection with Gruver's testimony when he was charged with second-degree burglary June 19. He subsequently was cleared on the burglary charge.

The perjury charge accuses Gruver of falsely testifying during his arraignment that he had not been convicted of a felony or any other charge. He has served prison sentences in Oklahoma, Colorado and Texas.
