

Fortuitous windfalls

Bus ticket stub

Marina found Mexican bus ticket stub, one way Mexico City to Laredo, purchased Oct. 1 or Oct. 2, while going through Oswald's belongings "last week". (SF Chronicle, Sept. 1, 1964 - AP, Dallas, 31 Aug. 1964; filed Chron.)

How is it possible this ticket stub was not found earlier?

Was it not among the items found and examined by the police and FBI? Difficult to believe in view of thorough search evidenced by detailed inventory of Oswald's possessions, listing such things as paper clips, one 10¢ stamp. (Search Nov. 22 and 23.)

Was it among the things picked up by the police, but missed by them and the FBI in their examination, then found by Marina after the items were returned to her, assuming they were returned?

Check if this ticket stub mentioned in Report or supplements. Probably not, as Report published Sept. 27, 1964.

Camera

Camera found by Robert Oswald, Dec. 8, 1963 in Paine house and turned over by him to FBI Feb. 24, 1964. Camera found by him after exhaustive searches of Paine house by police.
