

WARREN UNIT BACKED BY EDWARD KENNEDY

Washington, July 31 (UPI) - Senator Edward M. Kennedy said today that although he had not read the Warren Commission Report he was convinced Lee Harvey Oswald alone assassinated President Kennedy.

The 34-year-old Massachusetts Democrat said:

"I never read the Warren Commission Report. However, I am satisfied that it represents at least conclusively the results which I believe are accurate. I have not read it. And I do not intend to do so."

New York - ... /Robert F./ Kennedy, Democratic nominee for the United States Senate from New York, issued this statement through his campaign office:

"As I said in Poland last summer,* I am convinced that Oswald was solely responsible for what happened and that he did not have any outside help or assistance. He was a malcontent who could not get along here or in the Soviet Union.

"I have not read the report, nor do I intend to. But I have been briefed on it and I am completely satisfied that the commission investigated every lead and examined every piece of evidence. The commission's inquiry was thorough and conscientious." (AP)
