
**Kennedy, Ill With Pneumonia,
Votes No on Judge Carswell**

PALM BEACH, Fla., Feb. 16 (AP)—Senator Edward M. Kennedy, ill here with pneumonia, voted from his sickbed today against Senate Judiciary Committee approval of the Supreme Court nomination of Judge G. Harrold Carswell.

The Massachusetts Democrat, voting by telephone, was one of four members of the committee to oppose the nomination. Twelve voted in favor.

Senator Kennedy was reported improved but still with fever.

"His fever had been over 105," said his physician, Dr. Saul D. Rotter. "Now it is down quite a bit." The Senator is at the home here of his mother, Mrs. Joseph P. Kennedy.
