

Kennedy Wants Name Off Nebraska Ballot

LINCOLN, Neb., Feb. 24 (Reuters)—Senator Edward M. Kennedy has asked that his name be removed from the Democratic ballot for the Nebraska Presidential primary election on May 1.

The Massachusetts Democrat filed an affidavit stating, "I am not and do not intend to become a candidate for the office of President."

State officials said they would honor the request. Senator Kennedy, who has repeatedly said that he was not running for President next November, has used the same procedure in several other states.
