Salinger Says Ted Won't Run

(UPI) — Sen. Edward Kennedy (D-Mass.) has "taken himself out of the 1972 presidential race," according to Pierre Salinger, former press secretary to the late President John F. Kennedy.
"Ted didn't really want to run for President in 1972 anyway," Salinger said last night in an interview.

Referring to the death of Mary Jo Kopechne in an automobile accident in which Sen. Kennedy was the driver, Salinger predicted: "He'll come out of it."
