Federal Injunction Is Denied
On Kopechne Data Release
BOSTON, April 28 (AP) —
Judge Bailey Aldrich refused to to issue a Federal injunction to prevent the Massachusetts Superior Court from making public the transcript of the inquest into the death of Mary Jo Kopechne.
Sidney R. Lipman, the public stenographer who made the transcript, sent his lawyer, Jerome P. Facher, to the United in the First Circuit to make a last-minute attempte to halt issuance of the record.
Chief Justice G. Joseph Tauro has announced that he will issue copies to news agencies at the Suffolk Superior Court at 3 P.M. tomorrow.
Mr. Lipman has been fighting for the exclusive right to make copies of the transcript of testimony and the inquest judge's report. He lost in the state courts and twice before in the Federal courts.
