## A Reminder

On the fourth anniversary of the death of Mary Jo Kopechne, police in Edgartown, Mass., on Thursday found a cement cross with the name "Mary Jo" inscribed in it. The cross was submerged near the Chappaquid-

dick bridge where a car driven by Senator Edward M. Kennedy plunged into the water on July 19, 1969, killing Miss Kopechne. One police officer called the cross "the work of someone with a warped mind."
