Kennedys' Taxes

Senator and Mrs. Edward M. Kennedy paid 48 per cent of their 1973 gross income in federal income taxes, they disclosed yesterday.

Kennedy (Dem - Mass.) released to reporters his and

his wife's joint return which listed federal tax of \$217,844 on adjusted gross income of \$451,683.

In addition to his \$42,500 salary as a senator, Kennedy listed \$3355 in "literary and miscellaneous income,"

\$21,667 from dividends and \$397,377 from other income.

Of that latter figure, \$396,337 came from two trust funds, set up in 1926 and 1936 by his father, the late Joseph P. Kennedy.
