Edward M. Kennedy (D-Mass.) told him "Tip, I am not going to be a candidate for President of the United States." O'Neill added: "I see this as a final decision."

O'Neill, House majority leader and a close friend of the senator, had revived speculation that Kennedy would run despite the senator's previous denials.

When he appeared last Sunday on the CBS television program "Face the Nation," O'Neill said, "I think Ted Kennedy will be a candidate." And he quoted Kennedy as telling him "Keep me alive."

Talking to a few reporters yesterday, O'Neill said, "Anything I said in the past is absolutely accurate and true." However, he said Kennedy telephoned him Wednesday night, they talked about the presidency, and Kennedy then hade his disclaimer.
