Sen. Edward M. Kennedy (D.-Mass), was involved in a minor traffic accident Wednesday morning when the car he was driving collided with another vehicle while Kennedy was heading from his McLean home to work on Capitol Hill.

The accident occurred while both cars were merging into the same lane on the 14th Street Bridge, according to an aide in Sen. Kennedy's office. No one was hurt and the damage was confined to a dent in Kennedy's left rear fender, according to an aide. He identified the other driver as Rebecca Sperling, of 714 N. Kensington St., Arlington.

District police were not called the aide said, because police are required to be notified of a traffic accident only if there are injuries, if one of the vehicles involved is unoccupied, or if one of the vehicles is destroyed.
