

**A 2d Son as President?  
Mrs. Kennedy Willing**

PHILADELPHIA, April 29  
—Mrs. Joseph P. Kennedy, mother of the late President, said here today that she "would love to see" either of her Senator-sons in the White House.

At a news conference at the Bellevue-Stratford Hotel, Mrs. Kennedy said she would be pleased if either Senator Robert F. Kennedy of New York or Senator Edward M. Kennedy of Massachusetts, both Democrats, would run for the Presidency.

Both, she said, have had "wonderful" training and have "lived and worked politics."

"But I don't know how much longer I will be able to campaign for them," she said. "People retire at 65, you know."
