

**Mrs. Onassis Is 40;
Gets Apollo Earrings**

SKORPIOS, Greece, Monday, July 28 (UPI) — Mrs. Aristotle Onassis celebrated her 40th birthday today and among her gifts were jeweled earrings from her husband depicting the Apollo 11 mission.

It was President Kennedy who began the moon-landing program in 1961 and gave it its goal of a man on the moon in this decade.

Mrs. Onassis watched on television aboard the Onassis yacht Christina last week as her late husband's dream was realized.

The earrings consist of a sapphire-studded earth at the ear and a larger moon decorated with rubies hanging from a chain. The Apollo ship is attached to a thin gold thread, which circles the earth and drops to the moon.

It was reported that Mr. Onassis, one of the world's richest men, also gave his wife a 40-carat diamond—one carat for each year.
