Caroline Kennedy's Job Ends

EAGAN, Tenn. (UPI)—Caroline Kennedy has ended her brief summer stay in upper east Tennessee.

The 15-year-old daughter of the late President John F. Kennedy spent several weeks helping to shoot a federally funded documentary film on the history of coal mining in the Campbell County area.

Marie Cirillo, a former nun who has been working on community development programs in the area for six years, was Miss Kennedy's host during the visit. "The local people didn't bother Caroline much," she said, "but the national news media did."

The film project will continue without Miss Kennedy. "The project is a four-month thing and has several weeks to go," Miss Cirillo said.
