Jackie and Christina -- 'No Love'

London

Christina Onassis and Jacqueline Kennedy Onassis met secretly in London to discuss the estimated \$1 billion fortune left by Christina's father, a spokesman for the Onassis family said yesterday.

Christina, 24, is reported to be in dispute with her stepmother, the widow of President John F. Kennedy, over the Onassis millions.

"I don't know exactly what happened," spokesman Nigel Neilson said of the Wednesday meeting, which was held in the presence of lawyers.

"But it is certainly safe to assume that the question of finances was one of the things discussed," he said.

"There is not a lot of love lost between them."

Neilson said Christina had not made up her mind whether to marry Greek shipping heir Peter Goulandris, but that she also had not ruled out the possibility.

After her meetings in London, Christina flew to the Bahamas, where Goulandris' mother, Mrs. John P. Goulandris, maintains a home in Lyford Cay outside Nassau.

Mrs. Onassis reportedly flew to Athens after the meeting with her stepdaughter.
