

**Nixon Backs Route Plans
To Robert Kennedy's Grave**

WASHINGTON, Feb. 1 (AP)

—The White House said Saturday that President Nixon had approved plans to provide public access routes to Senator Robert F. Kennedy's grave in Arlington National Cemetery.

The Defense Department recommended a \$431,000 appropriation for the project, but former President Lyndon B. Johnson omitted specific mention of it in his budget and

left the matter to his successor.

The White House Press Secretary, Ronald L. Ziegler, said today that Mr. Nixon was aware of the project and "is favorably disposed to the proposal."
