

Grave Site Contract Let For Robert F. Kennedy

WASHINGTON, Nov. 4 (UPI) — A Government contract was let today for construction of a permanent grave site for Senator Robert F. Kennedy at Arlington National Cemetery.

The Army said the construction would cost \$747,000, with the Government paying \$181,000 and the Kennedy family \$566,000.

It will include a granite plaza and a reflecting pool adjacent to the grave of President Kennedy who was also assassinated.

The major contract went to Roubin & Janeiro of Fairfax, Va., which also did the major stone work for President Kennedy's grave. The architect for the project is I. M. Pei of New York.
