Carroll Lewis Trapnell, after a flight had returned en route from Los Angeles to New York City on 12/14, was arrested at a nearby airport and taken to the FBI, where he was held for a few days. A plane was still at the airport at the time of his arrest, and was under the control of the FBI.

New Orleans state-1201 1/26/72 (from Dallas file 1201) says accounts in Davis at the time of Trapnell was questioned by FBI 19 Aug 65, when he told that he had met with three Cuban refugees who were planning to assassinate Bill Robert Kennedy. Trapnell was arrested by FBI again 2/27/66, at which time he substituted the name "Fuentes" for one of the Cuban refugees with whom he said he had met in Paris in May 63. The only other name mentioned is that of Juan Manuel Fuentes. (There is some confusion in story at this point: it was Trapnell telling FBI that he met in Paris with this man and two others who were plotting to kill Robert Kennedy.) Trapnell later denied this story, saying he had fabricated it to confuse matters surrounding a bad check charge against him in 1966.
