Other Candidates Under Guard

WASHINGTON — (UPI) — President Johnson, who spent much of the night watching television accounts of the shooting of Robert Kennedy; ordered the Secret Service to immediately assign a detail to guard the other presidential candidates.

Johnson consulted during the night with Attorney General Ramsey Clark and FBI Director J. Edgar Hoover. The attorney general ordered the FBI into the case under authority of the Voting Rights Act of 1965 and the Civil Rights Act of 1968.

Clark also ordered James P. McShane, Chief U.S. marshal, to take command of a guard posted at Kennedy's home, Hickory Hill, in suburban Fairfax County, Va.
