

Jackie Hears News From London Kin

LONDON — (AP) — Mrs. John F. Kennedy learned in New York about the shooting of Sen. Robert F. Kennedy today by means of a London telephone call she thought concerned her brother-in-law's victory in the California primary.

Mrs. Kennedy's sister, Princess Lee Radziwill, had accompanied her husband, Prince Stanislaus Radziwill, to Heathrow Airport for a flight to New York.

"My husband had a telephone call at our home to tell

him of the shooting," Princess Radziwill said.

"He immediately phoned my sister in New York. She knew nothing of what had happened. She said 'yes, you heard that he won California by 53 percent.'"

"My husband asked 'but how is he.'

"She replied, 'I just told you, he won California.'

"She just didn't know the real story behind it all. It was the middle of the night in America and she had been asleep. She was terribly stunned."
