

Sirhan Kin Beaten, Photo Stolen

Saidallah Bishara Sirhan, 35-year-old brother of Sirhan Bishara Sirhan, 24, accused assassin of Sen. Robert F. Kennedy, told Pasadena police he was beaten and robbed of a photograph Wednesday night by a man who said he wanted it for a national magazine.

Sirhan told police "two polite men who said they were from a magazine" came to his home at 1639 N. Lake Ave. early Wednesday evening and asked

for a photograph of him. He said he declined and they left.

About 11:30 p.m., he said his front door was kicked in and a 200-pound, six-foot tall man raged into his home, struck Sirhan on the jaw with his fist and said, "Damn it, we're going to kill all you Arabs."

Sirhan said he retreated into his living room where he sat on the couch urging the man to

calm down.

He said the man then glared around the room, said, "If you don't give your picture, we're going to take it."

Sirhan said he then took a photograph of Sirhan from a table in front of the couch and walked out.

Sirhan said another man waited outside the front door during the robbery and he couldn't see him clearly.
