"Kennedy was killed by his own tongue," Sirhan's father told newsmen Sunday, referring to the senator's recent statement

supporting Israel. He said he agreed with Mohammed Mehdi, head of the American-Arab Action Committee in New York, blaming the assassination on the volatile Middle East situation.
