

Youth Held In 'Revenge' Shooting

CHICAGO — (AP) — Police today arrested Aaron Myers, 19, in connection with the death of a Jordanian grocer who may have been shot in revenge for the assassination of Sen. Robert Kennedy.

Myers was charged with the murder of Abder Rayyan, 66, the father of nine children.

Rayyan was shot in the head Saturday as he bent over a vegetable bin in his store, his daughter, Zuhdeia, 22, who witnessed the shooting, told police.

She said two men entered, one of them pulled out a pistol and they walked silently to where Rayyan was working. The gunman put the pistol behind Rayyan's left ear and fired twice, she said. The second shot missed.

After the shooting, police noted the man charged with murdering Kennedy, Sirhan Bishara Sirhan, 24, is a native of Jordan.

Rayyan left Jordan 16 years ago and lived in South America until 1963 when he came to the United States.
