RFK's Driver Beaten, Robbed By 7 Youths

WASHINGTON — (AP) — Lee Morrow, personal driver for Sen. Robert Kennedy, was beaten and robbed early yesterday after being on duty for 24 hours with the grieving family.

Morrow, 45, was stopped by seven juveniles a block from his Northwest Washington home. They hit him in the face with a stick and took his wallet. containing 50 cents and three gasoline credit cards in Kennedy's name.

Morrow was not seriously hurt, police said.
