County Supervisor Kenneth Hahn said he had asked for the appropriation, which could be up to \$20,000, after discussions on the suspect's security with Sheriff Peter Pitchess and Judge Donald R. Wright of Superior Court.
Mr. Hahn said the need for the protective bubble in court to guard against anattempt on the 24-year-old Jordanian's life was "a great emergency."
He declined to describe the covering exactly, except to say that it would be made of armor plating and bullet-proof glass.
