
**Truck Is Used to Move
Sirhan Trial Transcript**

LOS ANGELES, Sept. 5' (UPI)—The appeal lawyers for Sirhan B. Sirhan used a truck today to pick up the court reporters' transcript of his trial for the murder of Senator Robert F. Kennedy.

The lawyers, Luke Mc Kissack and George Shibley, drove the truck to the Hall of Justice to get the record.

The transcript runs 1.35 million words and fills 108 volumes. The trial began Jan. 9 and Sirhan was sentenced to death May 21. He is in San Quentin State Prison awaiting the outcome of an appeal, which may extend for years.
