

Jury to Probe Charges Over Sirhan Evidence

The county grand jury will investigate charges that unauthorized persons had access to evidence used to convict Sirhan B. Sirhan of the assassination of Senator Robert F. Kennedy, it was announced yesterday.

District Attorney Joseph P. Busch Jr. said in a statement that his own probe of the matter disclosed that "a number of individuals" have examined the original exhibits without the required court order.

The exhibits include the slugs removed from Kennedy's body, bullets used for test firings, the pistol Sirhan carried and the coat Kennedy was wearing.
