In California, state officials said that Sirhan B? Sirhan, the convicted assassin of Senator Robert F. Kennedy, had refused to appear at a parole hearing scheduled for him Monday. The officials said Sirhan declined to give a reason for not appearing. Sirhan's death penalty was changed to life imprisonment under a United States Supreme Court ruling, making him eligible for a parole hearing although he may not be paroled until he has served a minimum of seven years in prison. He was sent to San Quentin Prison's death row in 1969.
