

Bogus Usher at Funeral Of Dr. King Is Committed

WASHINGTON, May 3—Floyd (Buddy) Ayres, an associate of the Ku Klux Klan who posed as an usher at the funeral of the Rev. Dr. Martin Luther King Jr., has been committed to St. Elizabeths Federal Mental Hospital in Washington.

Mr. Ayres, a Secret Service spokesman said, appeared at the northwest gate to the White House grounds April 21 and told the guards there he wanted to give a message to the President. He displayed an envelope.

The guards had a "conversation" with Mr. Ayres, the spokesman said, and decided he was mentally disturbed. Secret Service officials then sent him to St. Elizabeths for observation.
