Suspect in King Case Cleared

SAN JUAN (Puerto Rico) — (AP) — The FBI said today a man seen in San Juan is not the suspect sought in the slaying of Dr. Martin Luther King.

An FBI spokesman said in-

vestigators checked out a report of two girls in Hartford, Conn., that they had seen a man resembling James Earl Ray, alias Eric Starvo Galt, at the airport here last week.

The girls said the man acted nervous and wanted a ticket for any place in South America. They said he refused an offer of a ticket to Miami.
