MEMPHIS, Tenn. AP - Memphis authorities said Tuesday that a \$100,000 reward "for information leading to arrest and conviction" in the death of Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. cannot be claimed until a conviction takes place.

The Commercial Appeal offered a fourth of the amount, the Memphis Press-Scimitar came up with another \$25,000, several smaller offers were made and the city agreed to underwrite the difference to top the figure off at \$100,000.

The Federal Bureau of Investigation, the Royal Canadian Mounted Police and other agencies that worked in the King manhunt have not indicated whether the arrest of James Earl Ray in London was on the basis of information given by a private citizen.

Ray has been indicted by the Shelby County Grand Jury on a charge of murdering King here April 4.
