THREE ASSASSINATIONS, by Sylvia Meagher

Article points to signs of conspiracy in murders of JFK, King and RFK and suggests they may be inter-connected. "If the assassinations were random crimes by unstable individuals unconnected with each other or with anyone else, the law of chance would decree random victims convering the whole political spectrum. But the victims in each case were men opposed to the Vietnam war and championing, to greater or lesser degree, radical programs to redistribute wealth and power to the dispossessed."

HOW MANY CONSPIRACIES? by Conor Cruise O'Brien

Author believes the assassinations of President Kennedy and King may be connected ("the same pattern of veto by assassination" involving a right wing group) but doubts that Robert Kennedy's murder fits into same picture. "It is obviously difficult to comment on this at present, but if the person apprehended and charged is in fact the assassin .. his reason would be connected rather with the use of America's power in the world outside, and the ease with which American political figures discuss and favor the application of force."
