New Trial For Ray Is Possible

James Earl Ray could be returned here within two weeks for a hearing to establish whether he is entitled to a new trial in the assassination of Dr. Martin Luther King Jr.

A letter from Ray to criminal court Judge W. Preston Battle, coupled with Battle's death on Monday, raised questions that can only be answered in a judicial hearing with Ray present, a legal source said.
