Honor for Rev. King Revoked

MONTGOMERY (Ala.) — (AP) — The City Commission has changed its mind and decided that no part of Jackson Street in Montgomery should be renamed in honor of the late Dr. Martin Luther King.

With Mayor Jim Robinson dissenting, Commissioners Jack Rucker and Cliff Evans voted yesterday to rescind an earlier resolution which had named seven blocks along the street for King.

White and black residents like had objected to the proposed name change. The whites said no part of the street — named for President Andrew Jackson — should be changed; blacks said all and not just part of it should bear King's name.
