A Superior Court judge ordered psychiatric examinations yesterday for the man charged with killing Mrs. Martin Luther King Sr.

Judge Sam Phillips McKenize ordered the tests for Marcus Wayne Chenault, a 23-year-old Dayton, Ohio, resident, to determine if he is "mentally capable" of assisting his attorney, Randy Bacote, in preparation of his defense; if Chenault could determine between right and wrong at the time of the alleged offense, and "any other petinent matter relating to accused's mental capbability of standing trial for said offense or offenses."

Chenault is charged with two counts of murder and one of aggravated assault.
