**Convicted Killer  
Of Mrs. King  
Loses Appeal**

ATLANTA, April 10 (UPI)—The state supreme court has rejected an appeal of the death sentence for Marcus Wayne Chenault in the murder of Mrs. Martin Luther King Sr.

Chenault's attorney had appealed the conviction and sentence given his client in the June 30, 1974 shooting at Ebenezer Baptist Church in which Mrs. King and church deacon Edwin Boykin were slain.

In its decision upholding the verdict, the supreme court Wednesday cited testimony from two psychiatrists who judged Chenault capable of determining right from wrong at the time of the crime and mentally competent to stand trial.
