In response to questions, Mr. Levi also said that the Justice Department might consider, among other alternatives, the appointment of a special prosecutor to reinvestigate the assassination of the Rev. Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. He said that the Civil Rights Division of the Department was reviewing the entire collections of about 90 files on the King assassination to see if there were flaws in the prior investigations.

He saidthat he would wait until the review was completed and recommendations made to him before making any statements about a special prosecutor or other actions.
