A Photo of Dita, Anderson Aide

Washington

Senator Marlow Cook (Rep-Ky.) has made public a picture showing ITT lobbyist Dita Beard and a secretary to columnist Jack Anderson at a party. It was part of Cook's effort to depict the two women as friends and drinking companions.

The picture showed the International Telephone and Telegraph Corp. lobbyist and Anderson's secretary, Opal Ginn, in a group celebrating the retirement of Bill Burazer after 25 years as a waiter at the Sheraton - Carlton hotel.

Anderson was not in the photograph. Although he has acknowledged he was at the party, he and Miss Ginn have submitted sworn affidavits to the committee that they barely knew Mrs. Beard.

The Washington Post said it had learned that the photograph "was supplied to Cook by the White House, which has launched an extensive search for facts that might discredit the columnist."
