

# ITT Lobbyist Due To Leave Hospital

DENVER — (UPI) — Dita Davis Beard, Washington lobbyist for the International Telephone & Telegraph Corp., may be released from the Rocky Mountain Osteopathic Hospital by the end of the week.

Mrs. Beard, 53, who was stricken with a heart seizure Sunday as she testified before a Senate panel, was re-

ported progressing steadily today at the hospital.

Mrs. Beard has been confined to the hospital since March 3 for treatment of a heart ailment.

"She is much better," said Dr. Lewis Radetsky. The doctor said she would remain in the Denver area for at least a week after her release and would receive treatment as an outpatient.
