Nixon Won't Be at Sheraton

WASHINGTON — (UPI) — President Nixon will stay at his San Clemente Western White House during the Republican convention in San Diego and not at the Sheraton Hotel, the White House has reiterated.

President Harold Geneen of International Telephone and Telegraph told the Senate Judiciary Committee that ITT's commitment to provide at least \$200,000 to help pay the costs of the convention was conditioned on Nixon making the Sheraton his headquarters. The hotel is now under construction.

Sheraton Hotels is a subsidiary of ITT.
