'Severe'

Heart Attack

DENVER — (UPI) — ITT lobbyist Dita Davis Beard suffered "acute heart spasms" yesterday. Her doctors described the attack as "definitely severe," but said she did not require hospitalization.

She was given medication and oxygen, then placed under the care of a private nurse who spent the night with Mrs. Beard in her rented Denver apartment.

The latest attack may thwart any immediate hopes that Senate Judiciary Committee members might have had to question the outspoken lobbyist further about the ITT antitrust case.
