ITT Probe Political -Reagan

SACRAMENTO — The Senate Judiciary Committee's long hearing into the International Telephone and Telegraph Corp.'s connection with the Republican national convention "is political harassment," Gov. Reagan said today.

Reagan, chairman of the California Committee to Reelect the President, defended the testimony yesterday by Lt. Gov. Ed Reinecke and the latter's aide, Edgar Gillenwaters.

Sen. Birch Bayh (D-Ind), a member of the committee, said he had a "gut feeling" that the pair had committed perjury.

"I have perfect confidence that the Lieutenant Governor and Gillwaters were speaking the truth," Reagan said.
