ITT Buys \$11,500 Ad

In Program

MIAMI BEACH — (UPI)

— International Telephone and Telegraph Corp., which figured in a political controversy over financing of the 1972 Republican National Convention, has taken out an \$11,500, full-page color advertisement in the official convention program.

The ad, on page 87 of the 290-page booklet, reproduces Abraham Lincoln's "With Malice Toward None" quotation on a field of red, white and blue. The magazine, distributed free, stands to net the Republican Party \$1.4 million in advertising revenues.

ITT's offer to underwrite GOP Convention costs in San Diego by at least \$200,000 prompted Senate hearings into Democratic suggestions the offer was connected with the Justice Department's out-of-court settlement of antitrust action against the giant conglomerate. The nominating sessions were switched to Miami Beach after the hearings started.
