Chinese Aide Amused

By Intervention Query

PARIS, May 13 (AP) — Chinese Deputy Premier Teng Hsiao-ping burst into laughter when asked how Peking would react to a possible American intervention to recover a U.S.

merchant ship captured by Cambodia.

"If they intervene, there is nothing we can do," Teng told reporters.

Other Chinese officials accompanying Teng, regarded as the No. 3 person in the Peking hierarchy, also laughed

at his remark. Teng left in Giscard d'Estaing on the second day of his official visit to France and said: "We had some very frank discussions on the international problems which interest us." He indicated that the subjects discussed included Indochina and Europe, but gave no details.

Teng emerged from the Elysee palace after a one-hour meeting with President Valery
