"N.S. Finney, Washington bureau chief of the Buffalo News, has theorized that Cuban exiles may have been involved [in the assassination]. In a speech in Buffalo Feb. 8, Finney noted that Oswald arrived in Mexico City Sept. 28, five days after it was announced that Kennedy would visit Dallas, and immediately checked into the Hotel Commercio, a residence 'substantially used by Cuban exiles.'

"Also, Finney said, the 'Cuban exile community was brought to rage' following the arrest in Virginia Sept. 27 of 'the authentic Cuban exile leader in this country on charges of attempting to counterfeit Cuban money.' Because of this, he said, 'the exiles again felt they had been betrayed by President Kennedy.'"
